

Programme-Specific Criteria

To be admitted to an undergraduate programme, applicants must meet the minimum secondary school grade requirements or their equivalent, as shown in the table below. If the school's grading system differs, our admission team will convert it accordingly.

For an undergraduate applicant who does not meet the minimum required secondary school grades in Mathematics and English or their equivalent, admission will depend on the following criteria:
